

Continuous Improvement Engineer

General:

The purpose of this role is to drive continuous improvement activity to deliver improved operational efficiency, effectiveness and enhanced customer experience. Duties & Responsibilities:

- Lead Cambus Medical's continuous improvement (CI) program ensuring that agreed activities are completed on schedule and that agreed program objectives are achieved.
- Implement and sustain CI activities and programs such as continuous flow, A3 problem solving, kaizen, setup reduction, 5S, process optimisation, waste reduction.
- Support, mentor and coach teams during the implementation of lean operations principles.
- Facilitate kaizen events and conduct training events aimed at developing the capability of participants in lean principles.
- Work with a cross functional team in the successful deployment of Change Management across the site.
- Perform data gathering, root cause analysis and performance trending.
- Provide comprehensive tracking of improvements and their respective benefits.

- The successful candidate will have a strong background in Continuous Improvement with a minimum of 3yrs experience in lean implementation in a manufacturing environment.
- Qualification in lean operations (Green Belt, Black Belt).
- Degree Qualification in Engineering (Level 7) an advantage.
