- Design jigs and fixtures to meet manufacturing requirements and optimise machine changeover.
- Follow safe systems of work, taking reasonable care of their own health and safety, and that of others. Eliminating or reducing risks where practicable by complying with site safety rules and instructions and reporting hazards to management for prompt action
- Engage constructively with other functions within the Company to drive continuous improvement.
